

# GREETINGS

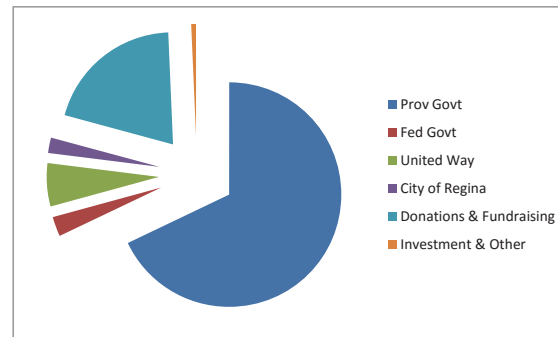

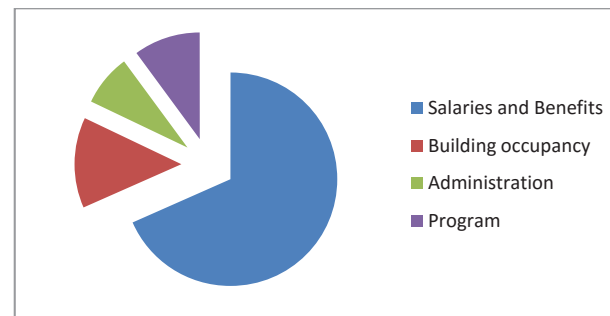
